Thanks to the active recruitment and hard work of MECC staff, MECC has officially maximized enrollment in our GSRP Preschool program filling all 32 seats with more families seeking enrollment! This year MECC staff attended the WISD Early Childhood Conference where all
- B. Riverside Every week we are celebrating a different staff member at Riverside. We are spot lighting our staff in the main office and including the communication in the Riverside times. Deidra LaPointe has moved to 3rd grade and we are excited about her being part of our team. Ashley Rickert filled a 4th grade position on short notice in a substitute capacity and we appreciate her willingness to accept the position. Students are voting to name the new signature sauce. Food service has been creating new sauces as part of the lunch program and getting feedback from the kids!
- C. Jr-Sr High School At Manchester, students are welcomed into one of four multi-grade-level Houses each managed by a faculty Dean and student House Captains. Students are assigned to Houses in a way that ensures there is a diverse cross-section of the student body in each House. The House placement has been given to each student and they will continue as a member of their House through graduation and beyond.
- D. Athletics Fall sports seasons are started. Varsity Football team off to a great start with a 3-0 season. Work on the track was completed in time for the first home varsity football game last Friday. Track and bleachers look great, new ticket booth on the north end looks great. We are

Fans have been instructed to park in the high school parking lot or the Klager Drive and parking lot. Homecoming Football game is Oct. 3rd against Leslie. Alina Baran is our new sideline cheer coach, Amelia Woods and Jennifer Alexa are volunteer assistants. Will Bennett is our new Middle School football coach with Wes Gall and Jeff

Guinn are volunteer assistants. We are still trying to find an athletic trainer and have been in contact with every provider in the area. Unfortunately, there is a shortage of athletic trainers but we will keep searching.

- E. Special Education Six newly enrolled students added to department caseloads. Fall Pupil Count moved to October 1, 2025 by MDE. All new students must have IEPs completed by September 30, 2025 to be included in the fall count and reported as compliant. Staff are in the process of scheduling these IEPs. The CBI Classroom at MHS closed for the 2025-2026 school year due to low enrollment trends into this program. Secured a Cooperative Agreement with the Chelsea School District for the 2 impacted students. Offer of FAPEwas provided to impacted parents.
- F. Technology With a few bumps we had a great start to the year. Klager Technology is still being delivered and some additional work is being done in the evenings to get everything buttoned up but overall everything is going well.
- G. Business Office The Auditors are on site conducting the audit September 9th -11th, 2025. At the time of this report (September 10, 2025), the State of Michigan has not finalized the FY 2026 budget. Because our financial plan depends on state appropriations negotiated by the House, Senate, and Governor, this delay introduces uncertainty. In the meantime, we are concentrating on what we can control: advancing cost-saving measures, maintaining student supports, and continuing curriculum alignment. Michigan's state fiscal year begins October 1, 2025; if a budget is not enacted by that date, a brief shutdown is possible. We will keep the Board informed as developments occur. Districts statewide are increasingly concerned about the situation
- H. Buildings & Grounds -Postives for this month are our staff. And working with Moore Trosper. Pending work orders are below 600.
- I. Food Service As of writing this update on 09/09/2025, there has not been any communication or updates from the state regarding funding for free school meals. Exact plans are still being finalized but we're excited to bring a wide variety of activities, events and interactive opportunities all centered around the theme of "Taste the World: Your School Lunch Passport"
